Programme

The 5th EurOMA Summer School will focus specifically on Demand Driven Supply Chains. The need for congruence between product, marketing and supply chain strategy is heightened in today's turbulent world. It requires co-delivery of two potentially conflicting priorities: driving growth through innovation whilst simultaneously reducing costs. To successfully address this challenge the business needs to unite. No longer can the supply chain pursue cost reduction in splendid isolation. It needs to connect to the marketplace and ensure that the right supply chain strategy is developed to meet market needs.

The lectures will provide an overview of the knowledge and research on Demand Driven Supply Chains, and will draw on the subject expertise of faculty from around the globe. Each one-day module is devoted to specific subjects and features lectures, case studies group work and plenary discussion.
