Announcing the second EurOMA Summer School in OM!

Dear Colleague,

After the success of the first edition, we are pleased to announce the second **EurOMA Summer** School in Operations Management that will take place in Como (Italy), 5-9 July 2010.

The EurOMA Summer School is targeted at PhD students and young researchers in Operations Management from all over the world.

The main objective is to develop a common knowledge-base on Operations Management within the community of PhD students in OM. The Summer School can support PhD students in defining relevant research topics and understanding the complex and relevant links with other research streams close to their PhD topic. The School aims also at fostering the development of a network of young researchers in the field of OM that could become a forum for exchanging ideas and building research collaborations.

The second edition of the Summer School will focus specifically on *Supply Chain Strategy and Management*. The lectures will provide an overview of the research on supply chain strategy and management, and will deepen some of the most relevant topics of the discipline, such as:

- supply chain integration;
- supply chain performance and sustainability;
- global supply chain management.

Each one-day module is devoted to a specific subject and features lectures, teamwork and discussion.

Target Group and Eligibility

Eligible candidates are PhD students in Operations Management from all over the world. Applications from young researchers in OM will also be considered, with second priority.

The number of participants is limited to 30. The selection will be based on the excellence of curriculum and the coherence between the research interests and the main topic of the school.
